Promise scholarship program

Indigenous high school students who will be graduating high school in 2022 and who are applying to attend a health-related program at a post-secondary institution for the next school year (Fall of 2022 or Winter 2023) can apply for NT-NEIHR's promise scholarship program.

To be eligible to apply, a student is required to:

- Identify as First Nations, Métis, or Inuit; and
- Must be from or living in the Northwest Territories; and
- Be a Grade 12 student during the 2021-2022 academic year
- Have a minimum of 75% average in their grade 11 high school courses; and
- Be planning to apply to at least one health-related program at a university, college or other post-secondary institution that begins the following school year (Fall 2022 or Winter 2023) or be able to describe how your educational path will provide you the opportunity to get into or work in a health field.

The available funding is between \$1,000-\$1,500 per promise scholarship award:

- A portion of funds (\$500) will be awarded to successful applicants when they officially accept an offer of admission to a health-related program for the next school year
- The remaining funds will be awarded when the student officially begins their post-secondary program (in Fall 2022 or Winter 2023)
